INVOLVEMENT IN ART:

Since retiring from a career of art education and classroom teaching 20 years ago, Carmen has worked as a full time artist. She paints in a loose impressionistic style that depicts real-life situations and scenes, then continues to manipulate the composition and colour combinations so that there is subtle or dynamic movement as the eye navigates the canvas. **Water** is a predominant theme which offers interesting variety and the opportunity to create emotive passages .

Carmen has travelled extensively to gather a diversity of resource material for her solo exhibitions and enjoys capturing the essence of Rottnest and the south west coast of W.A. She also researches places such as Bali, India, Italian countryside, the Greek Islands, Morocco, Spain, the French and Italian Riviera and Venice.

Whilst pursuing personal growth as an artist, Carmen has always valued the need to work with community art groups. She currently runs workshops throughout Australia and overseas and has participated in many “Artist in Residence” programs- directing, demonstrating and facilitating painting sessions in inspiring locations locally and around the world.

“COASTAL PASSAGE”

WARM UP ACTIVITY

Transparent water

Learn technique of preparation with underpainting, then simplifying the information from the photo reference so as to capture the essence of moving water, transparency and submerged seaweed.

COASTAL PASSAGE

From the cliff backdrop, to shoreline, then to the body of water, artists will engage in abstract mark making - dragging paint across the surface, drips, stencils, block printing, calligraphic mark making; option of combining oil and acrylic for interesting effects. The overall effect has representational result when all these techniques are applied.

This piece needs to be done in stages. I will be demonstrating , then directing artists through each step.
